

The Child Care Counts Emergency Payment Plan was created by the Wisconsin Department of Children and Families to support child care providers through the COVID-19 pandemic. (dcf.wisconsin.gov/covid-19/childcare/payments)

Funding has been awarded across multiple time periods since March 2020, and providers could apply for multiple awards in each period. Providers could apply for funds across 5 programs to support staff/business needs.
